Some of these courses are academic in nature, some are specifically to support with mental wellbeing and mindfulness.

### Online training

Our online training courses are open to residents and staff alike. Unemployed and furloughed residents - they are open to all. We have partnered with South Essex College and Learning Curve to create a range of courses - to support during this time.

### Our online course offer is accessed here: -

Working in partnership with South Essex College - Criteria - applicant be over 19 years old and have lived in the UK for over 3 years. Applicants must achieve minimum of level 1 in an English assessment prior to course acceptance.

These courses are accredited at Level 2

We are also working with Learning Curve who are also able to offer a wide range of courses all at different levels, but which are all accredited. Criteria - applicant must be 19+ and a UK resident for at least 3 years.
