We are also able to help with matters concerning private tenants or property owners although we do not have the same powers in dealing with private properties we can sometimes offer help and advice or point you in the right direction. We also organise free events throughout the City.

What can STRF do for you?

If you have an unresolved issue with your property or tenancy then we may be able to help in some way. STRF have the knowledge and means to help take on issues regarding repairs, maintenance and tenancy issues with South Essex Homes properties and can offer advice to everyone else.

Do you feel your estate, road or area would benefit by having a Residents Association but are unsure as to how to proceed?

STRF are able to guide you through the process of setting up a Residents Association or Group within South Essex Homes properties, estates or areas that contain a majority of their properties. We actively monitor these Associations or Groups and welcome any input from them and will assist them in organising their own events etc. There is a huge benefit in having an Association or Group in your area as a means of information sharing between your fellow residents and STRF.

What you can do to help STRF.

We hold regular monthly meetings where your input is the best way to raise any issues you may have.
